The SIGDA University Booth at the Design Automation Conference provides an opportunity for the university community to demonstrate EDA tools, design projects, and instructional materials in the Exhibits section of the Design Automation Conference. Presenters and attendees at DAC are especially encouraged to participate, but participation is open to all members of the university community. Participants will conduct a one-hour demonstration at the booth each day. The University Booth provides booth space, poster areas, computers, and a high-speed connection to the Internet.

Participants at the University Booth are also provided with modest travel grant reimbursements, provided that posters are hung for the entire duration of the conference and that demonstrations are completed during the time slots that they are scheduled. Participants who receive funding for the conference via alternative sources such as the Ph.D. forum and Student Design Contest are not eligible for travel grants through the University Booth.
